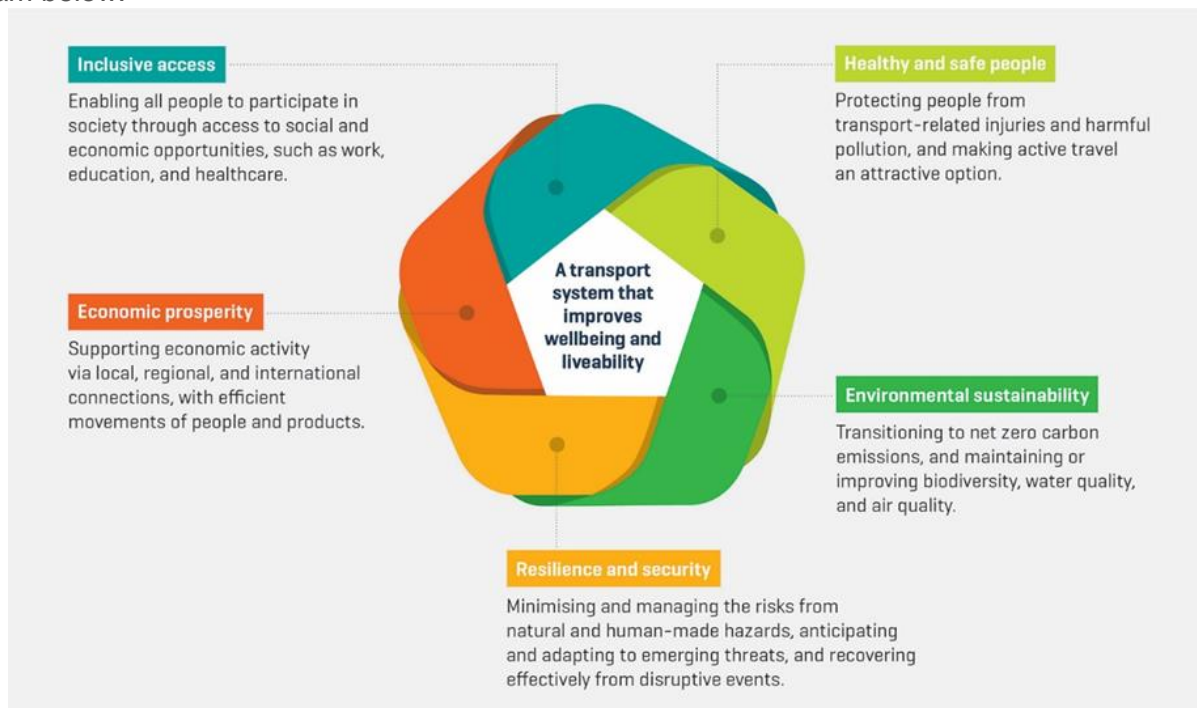
Call for papers

Paper abstracts are invited to be considered for the 2018 Transport Knowledge Conference (TKC) to be held in Wellington on Thursday 15 November 2018.

The 2018 Knowledge Conference will bring an exciting mix of keynote addresses, papers, and a panel session. A networking event will conclude the conference.

Themes

The theme this year for the TKC is '**Understanding and delivering transport outcomes**'. The purpose of the transport system is to improve wellbeing and liveability. It does this by contributing to five key transport outcomes. These outcomes will shape the conference sub-themes. The outcomes are included in the diagram below.

Presentation format

Oral presentations will be allocated 20 minutes. This includes a 12-15 minute presentation followed by discussion. Presenters will be advised on further format information in their acceptance email.

Presenter registration

All presenters will need to register for the conference. Registration will have no cost, however presenters will need to meet their own travel and accommodation expenses.

An email about registrations will be sent out in late September 2018. All presenters must register by Monday 12 November 2018.
